Be aware who you are writing for. Be conscious of what the user needs to do. Tell the user what they need to know. Pronouns. Use first and second pronouns (I, we, us and you) to establish a connection with the user. Avoid third person nouns (Australian Government Department of X) and pronouns (he, she, it and they).

Use ‘s for words that end in ‘s’ to show possession if you pronounce the ‘s’ (for example, personal names). If you don’t pronounce the ‘s’ just use an apostrophe. Don’t use apostrophes for plural abbreviations or decades. Use apostrophes for substitutions of ‘is’, ‘us’ or ‘are’ and in other contractions.
