Bradford reagent: Dissolve 100 mg Coomassie Brilliant Blue G-250 in 50 ml 95% ethanol, add 100 ml 85% (w/v) phosphoric acid. Dilute to 1 liter when the dye has completely dissolved, and filter through Whatman #1 paper just before use. (Optional) 1 M NaOH (to be used if samples are not readily soluble in the color reagent). ...

Protein determination by the Bradford method - Rice University

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Into flasks or beakers weigh out accurately duplicate portions of about 0.7 g of the iron(II) solid 'M' provided. Add 30 cm³ of dil. sulfuric acid, 100 cm³ of water, 7 cm³ of 85% phosphoric acid and 5 drops of diphenylamine sulfonate indicator. Titrate with dichromate to a purple colour. Calculate the percentage of iron in the solid 'M'.

Determination of iron using potassium dichromate: Redox indicators

Acid hydrolysis, particularly two-stage sulfuric acid hydrolysis, is widely used to treat lignocellulosic materials to obtain sugars [23-27]. In the process, acid first breaks the matrix structure of the fiber into cellulose, hemicellulose, and lignin components [28], and then further reduces these polysaccharides into monosaccharides [29].
