Every parent in Scotland owes an obligation of aliment (the sum paid for maintenance) to his or her children until each child reaches the age of 18, or 25 where a child is undergoing appropriate training or education (section 1, Family Law (Scotland) Act 1985 (1985 Act)). The level of aliment will be determined by the parties' needs and resources, their earning capacities and all the circumstances of the case.
