This works for SP2013 too. 2013 has the Style Resource Readers group in the Master Page Gallery > Settings in Permissions for this document library. Adding "Everyone" to this group which has Restricted Read access solved this issue where a user saw this message when trying to create a new wiki page in the Pages library.
